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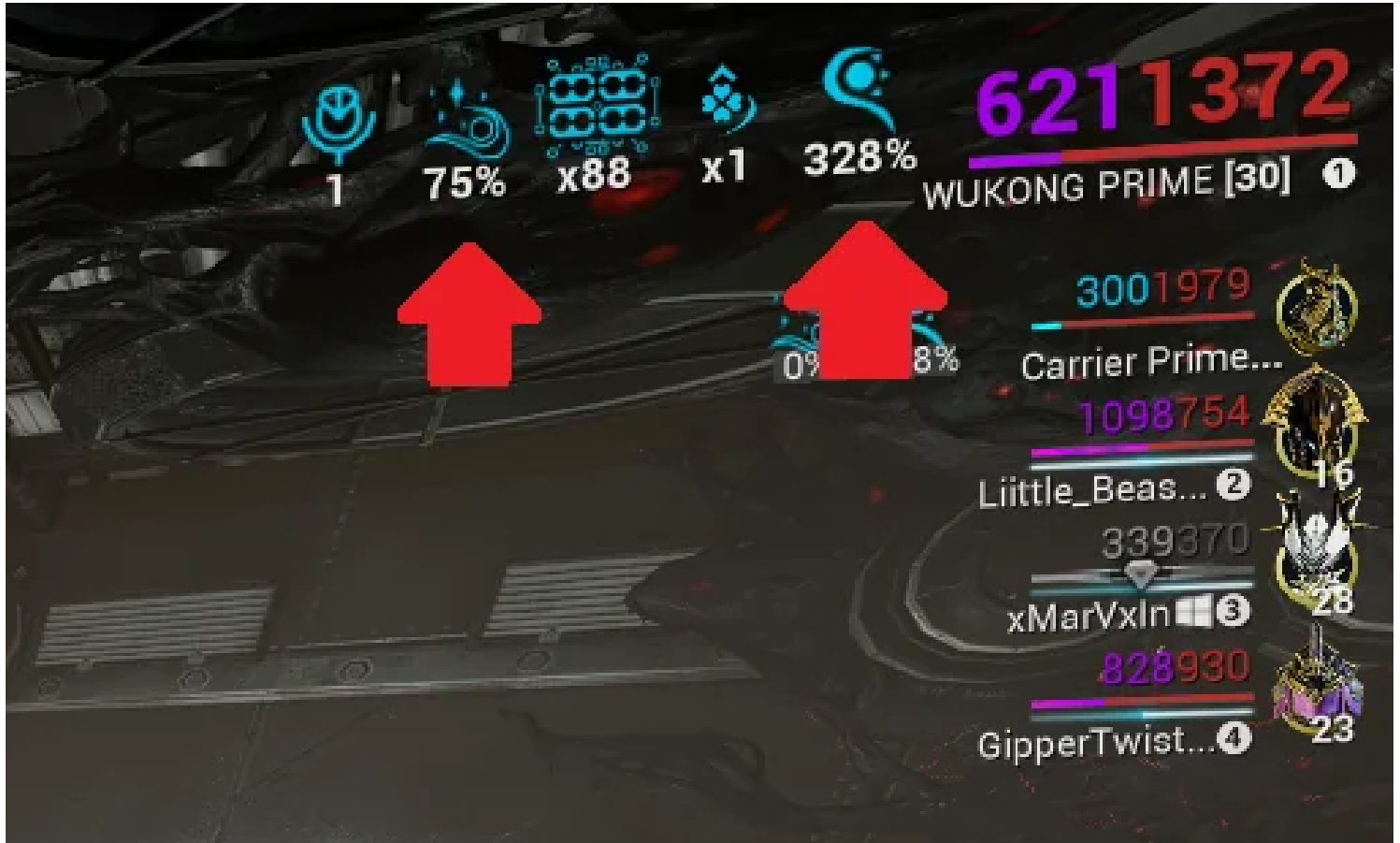

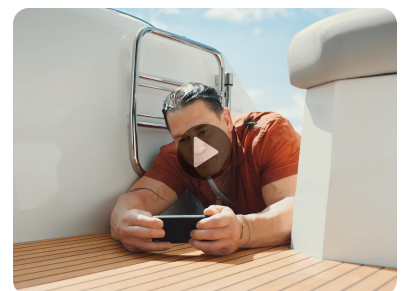

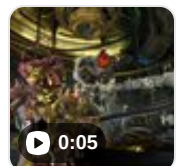

- Lower Eclipse has not changed; it still provides a base 75% Damage Reduction.
