




Is there a difference between equipping the melee and attacking or just quick attacking?

You know when you hold the *swap weapons* key you equip your melee weapon. Doing that changes anything such as blocking or parrying?





Yes, you only auto block in quick melee. When hard equipped, you have to manually block. Also, there are some Incarnon perks that only apply when the weapon is hard equipped (not quick melee). However, several of those perks are bugged. Either they always apply or just don't work. You'll have to look up each individual one on the Wiki to see how it works (or doesn't).
