Usage

Gravimags can be installed on an Archgun through the **Actions** tab on the [Arsenal's](#) Upgrade section. Only Archguns that have been upgraded with an [Orokin Catalyst](#) can have Gravimags installed on them.

Once an Archgun has been upgraded with a Gravimag, players can equip the upgraded Archgun in the **Heavy Weapon** tab of their **Vehicles** section, allowing the player to deploy an Archgun in ground combat via [Archweapon Deployer Gear](#) item.

A Gravimag is not required to be equipped to [Necramechs](#) called down via [Necramech Summon](#).
