The **Voidplume Quill** is an uncommon resource that is given to you when you use a [Zarium Accolade](#) on a [Cephalon Melica](#) console or defeating a [Ravenous Void Angel](#) in the [Zariman](#) Tileset. They can be exchanged for  **2,500** standing with [The Holdfasts](#). 15x Voidplume Quills are required to advance to the Rank 4 - Seraph with [The Holdfasts](#), and is an important crafting material for  [Gyre](#)'s systems,  [Styanax](#)'s systems, [Incarnon](#) weapons,  [Hespar](#),  [Aeolak](#),  [Phenmor](#) and [Parallax](#).

## Acquisition

- **Bounties** from **Quinn** award 1-5 Voidplume Quills depending on tier.
- Finding a **Zarium Accolade** and delivering it to a **Cephalon Melica Cache** in any Zariman mission awards 1 Voidplume Quill. Missions generally have two caches to find and unlock.
- **Ravenous Void Angels** that appear in **Void Armageddon** are guaranteed to drop a Voidplume Quill upon death as an interactable pickup.
- Every 8 hours, one Voidplume Quill can be purchased from **Archimedean Yonta** using **resources** found on the Zariman.
- Boosters have no effect on drop rate.
