

Notes

- For any non-integer magazine values the magazine size is simply rounded to the nearest whole number. For example, a  Angstrum modded with a max rank **Ice Storm** will have a calculated magazine size of $3 \times (1 + 40\%) = 4.2$, which will simply round to **4**.
- Ice Storm** gives a higher **magazine capacity** increase than its counterpart  Slip Magazine with an additional 10% bonus to magazine size as well as  Cold damage for the same cost, the only difference being that  Slip Magazine has a  polarity instead of Ice Storm's  polarity.
