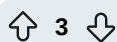

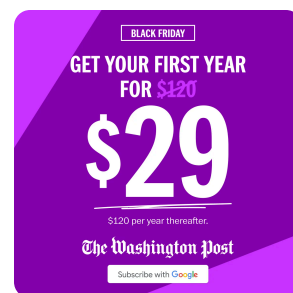

EVVA MCS is quite secure against picking... Kromer Protector is considered "unpickable"... As for anti-drill, my bet would be FAB1000 - I haven't seen another cylinder with that much steel in it yet... The reverse sidebar Yuema is considered unpickable too, yet it can be impressed... Unfortunately there is no easy answer to that question, otherwise there wouldn't be that many locks around. Plus there is the problem of lock not being the weakest link...

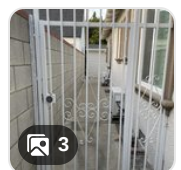

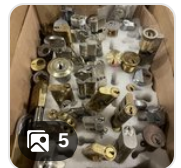
