It did get kind of warm as well but the manual said that's normal I guess but it would be nice to know what others think if anyone else has one.

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include the KSM60 and KSM70; and the service information refers to the old "commercial" architecture machines. (*)

It looks like it's a badge-engineered version of the KSM70, with a smaller bowl and less fancy accessories.

It should move very little on the countertop; when kneading heavy dough or large batches, make sure you keep the speeds low (speed "2" or below).

(* Speculation: it's possible that KitchenAid may be phasing out the old "Professional" design. This is decidedly mixed news: the Pro machines had a flawed design for the planetary which is addressed in the new design; but the new design has an integrated motor/transmission unit that isn't field-repairable and can only be replaced as a whole.)

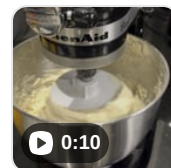

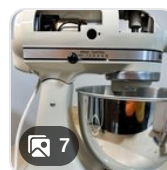

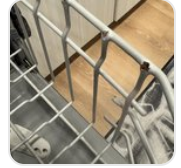
