
I know Of a program that's called "Dragon NaturallySpeaking" But I am not sure that it works in game and also for €400. Is a big deal of money

It's cheap (\$10) and has a free trial, but unfortunately dictation is not it's strong suit AFAIK. It's mostly designed for speak command -> execute button press/macro. It does have some support for dictation but it's not something I've delved into much and it was pretty limited last I checked. It's possible it's improved though.

At the very least, it would let you input some pre-programmed phrases of your choice into the chat fairly easily.


