Need help deciphering new LG Ultrafine model number 32UP83A - 32" 4k IPS

There's a new LG 32" 4k ips, 32UP83A-W. Anyone know how's it compare to LG 32UN650?

The specs seem identical besides the inclusion of USB-c on the 32UP83A, but it's 2 model years newer.

Would the newer panel be higher quality, just being 2 years newer? Is it just the same monitor with usb-c added maybe?

edit: 12/9/21 it's funny that this thread is one of the only places online discussing this monitor.

I ended up getting a 32UN880 for \$500 on cyber monday and I'm happy with it though I wish the stand rotated a full 360.

From studying the specs I believe the 32UP83A, 32UN650 and 32UN880 are all using the same panel, with the differences being USB-c and the stands. Hopefully some reviews can confirm soon!

- » [Acer Nitro VG240Y](#) or [Acer Nitro XV240Y](#) - Same price, just different stands. Freesync. The XV240Y OC's to 165hz. IPS panels
- » [BenQ MOBIUZ EX2510](#) – 1080p 144hz IPS, 24.5". Aesthetically beautiful and a fantastic alternative to the Acer Nitro.
- » [AOC C24G1](#) - VA, but a good budget option. Not best for fast paced gaming but usually can be found on good sales.
- » [Asus TUF VG259QM](#) - 25" and 280hz so it's perfect for competitive gaming.
- » [VIOTEK GFV24C](#) - Great design and thin bezel. VA and a great budget option for 144hz 1080p.

- » [Acer Nitro XV272U](#) - IPS, Considered to be the best budget monitor in this category
- » [LG 27GL83A-B](#) - IPS, - Reddit favorite mid-range monitor. Contrast is ok. Best combo of performance and value.
