My v4 pro has been perfect since day 1. No issues whatsoever.

I've had a Blackwidow Elite for 3-4 years now with zero issues.

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Third one has been typing very reliably. I had asked and found out this one I received was a recently manufactured version. It's only been about 3 weeks with this keyboard and so far, no sign of the double input/no input issue, thankfully.

Main difference I spotted was the Serial number started with IO24, the previous two with the issue had the serial number start with IO23, so I'm guessing that's the manufacturer year.

With the first two keyboards, the double/no input issue started showing up about a week after I had it and regularly used it. This one has no sign of any keys with the issue so far in the three weeks I've had it, so fingers crossed it's fixed?

Having the same question as you, I can tell you my experience with the keyboard that you can take it in mind

Bought a Blackwidow v4 X with yellow switches, one of the newest Razer models, loved it absolutely but in the first week of using it the keyboard had ghosting issues in one of the keys, particularly the "K", did the RMA with Razer but they don't give a damn, because I was in a country that they can't refund, did the RMA with the reseller, got a second keyboard and it failed in the same way during the first week of using it, now with the Alt, it began pressing like crazy or sometimes not responding, went to reseller again and gave up on a new Razer keyboard

Maybe too late but I would strongly advise you against it, I used the V2 until it died from old age and went to V4 Pro and it's awful, the orange tactile are defective, acknowledged by Razer themselves who offered to replace the main keys but with a catch.

(Typing without correcting) Anyway, my experience using it is very frustrating because I can't almost type a single sentence without my MM, S, A, E, I, G double typing or not typing at all as you can see from this paragraph, I only stuck with Black Widow because of the USB port and additional keys on the side but I regret buying this defective product and what's worst I got the 100% so I cannot swap the tactiles like the 75% 😞 They also said their Gen-3 orange tactile are the problem but the people bought their newest one that supposedly solved the problem, I think it was the yellow tactile and people are still having problems with it.
