It's about 7-18% more FPS depending on games. It does have extra 4GB of memory if you really need more than 20GB memory which you will never max out in most games even with RT on. That is mainly for things like if you do some Blender or Photoshop, video editing or machine learning.

Usually XTX is about 11% more in price which is worth it. Cause 18% more FPS for 11% more money is better value. But €300 is not worth it at all unless you don't care about that amount difference

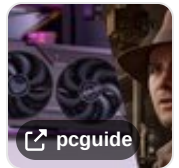

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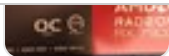
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
