I don't know the key bind on keyboard but on controller it is A/X and a direction with the left analog. Though you have to time it like a perfect block in order to pull it off and be standing almost still.

It is easier to do from a standstill. If moving change directions, other than forwards.

The timing is earlier than for a parry/masterstrike.

If you want to land a hit after a dodge, the highest percentage chance you have is if you're already holding an attack ready before you dodge and let it go right after your feet set.

When an enemy dodges left or right I have found they can almost never counter after if you attack to the side they dodged to. If they dodge backwards stab them in the face as they're resetting their feet.

Easiest way to practice, go to the training ring, back yourself into a corner then sprint to opposite corner, wheel 180 and get ready. 99% of the time Bernie or whomever you're practicing against will chase you and attack as soon as they reach you.

You can be holding block while dodging.
