

In my first playthrough, I was very actively trying to avoid progressing main quests, to explore every speck of the map and find as many secrets as possible. When the game told me to go through the gate, I said "Hell no" and went the other direction. Then suddenly I started getting these "Meanwhile.." cutscenes.

In NG+, I took care of the Talos and then let my pawn possess it in endgame.

After that run, I didn't bother with the Talos again. Once you have the achievment, it doesn't really add anything to the game. In my opinion it's more fun to have two extra endgame bosses to fight, than to fight the Talos.
