

Its extrodinarily simple - a single AT command will change the IMEI permanently. Before running the command, I suggest that you **write down your factory IMEI** and keep it somewhere safe as there is no way to automatically reset the IMEI back to the factory default.

Log into your X3000's GUI. On the main dashboard, select the **Modem Management** button (wrench+screwdriver icon) in the upper-right corner of the cell status, change "Shortcut" to **Manual command** and enter the following into the "AT command" box:

```
AT+EGMR=1,7,"012345678901234"
```

Note: change **012345678901234 to your new IMEI.

Then, press the **SEND** button. It'll come back with an OK. And then reboot your X3000. Log in again and verify that your new IMEI is in place. That's it.






