I can see that i didn't test it enough before i posted, it does not fully reset the fall height, but i did notice that there are atleast 3 different animations, one seems to be while heavy attacking, which causes you to bounce to one side aswell (unless that was just random), with light attack i did not bounce, and it seems like there is a difference where you will be knocked up, then continue falling, or you will be knocked up, land in the middle of the air, and then continue falling. I dont` know if maybe the latter effect is the one you want for a fall reset, or if you just have to blow up right before landing. But i also saw that if i was gliding down a hill, the flask could save me from death, exact same spot, with flask i survived twice, and without i died twice. Like i said i haven't done much testing, so there might be better ways to utilize this mechanic aswell.

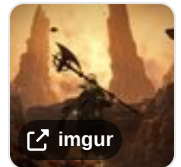
