Clarification for what SSD to replace my legion go internal storage with

QUESTION

Hey, I've read through quite a few posts now on what SSD's people are getting for their legion go, but i'm still unsure which one I should get myself. The console is primarily used for gaming, so i'm after a 2TB SSD that will allow for the most gaming (I assume correlating to high read/write speeds). After looking, I came across Corsair Force MP600 Micro 1TB M.2 2242 NVMe SSD (https://www.jw.com.au/product/corsair-force-mp600-micro-1tb-m-2-2242-nvme-ssd?gad_source=1&gclid=CjwKCAiArva5BhBiEiwA-oTnXR6ytVQzU5VERN-uwJ3KNNRcjd4xoGzegMSOf9YvehcJXMLI-fL2dhoClxgQAvD_BwE) but unsure if this is the best option. Could anyone explain whether this is a good SSD to get, and if not, what other alternative one I should get? (Either 2242 or 2230 with adapter)

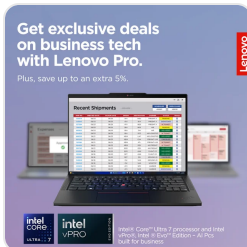

I used p3 plus, what you have to be careful with:

Heat - you can get a 10000mb/s ssd but it will probably consume a lot of Watts and reach temps that will bottleneck its speed

Thickness - if its too thick it will need you to either mod your backplate or buy a new one

To be safe just use a model that other people had used previously and gave good feedback here
