LG WOLEDs have always had black crush. It's just a limitation of the tech.

I guess you have already been adjusting the black levels in game optimizer? Check also to see if HGIG is on and switch to tone mapping instead. HGIG is supposedly more accurate but it's too dim for some games.

Try setting "fine tune dark areas" to +10 in the game optimizer menu, this should only be a game specific fix, not permanent. some games will react bad to this setting and you'll get a gray image when it should be black, titanfall 2 is a good example.

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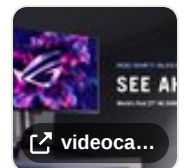
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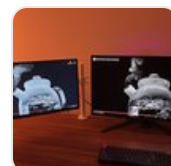
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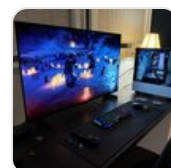
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
