It says " " Before running the USB BIOS Flashback tool, please rename the BIOS file (C7HWIFI.CAP) using BIOSRenamer."" - however, there is nowhere for me to download "BIOSrenamer" - the guides online i watched always have the BIOSrenamer downloading with the file but that doesnt happen for me. Can i use BRenamerl instead to do this? Please can someone help me, i am tearing my hair out over this.

Still, I don't understand why Asus doesn't provide the file with the right name already, or why they make a dedicated utility for such a basic operation as renaming a file, which anyone should be able to perform.
