Just got an S90c, under panel care the option to reduce logo brightness is medium (default) or High.

Does high mean higher brightness (so less severe dim) or does high mean more aggressive dim?

I would turn logo brightness to high. If the whole screen is dimming over time when gaming or other content this is likely to be another feature called auto brightness limiter (ABL). This feature will dim the screen if it believes content is paused or that there are many static features in the picture.

High mean more aggressive dimming, so set it to high if you can't see much difference or it doesnt bother you

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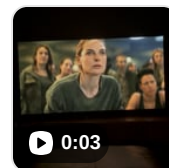
