We stayed at a hotel for five months but had to leave at least every 28 days for three days. The manager worked out a pretty sweet deal with us that was not on showing on the app, but basically we timed it so many of our three day departures were at peak tourist three day weekends (MLK, President's Day, Easter, Memorial Day) and effectively paid for four months by staying five. He got max dollars for our room and kept his occupancy rate up and we only did housekeeping twice a week...which is all I have at home so it was AOK with me. Some have a long term rate built in (Residence Inn in Sanibel and Tampa, and Fairfield Inn in Destin are some I've used) with a 31 day stay.

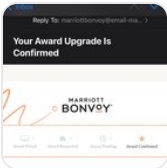

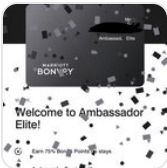
