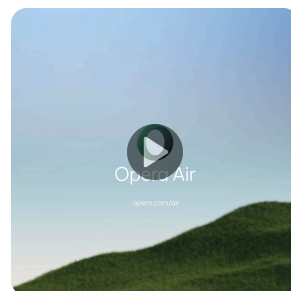

OP, I would not listen to these comments at all. Everyone here is only considering the 4060 vs the 4070. You probably should wait a little bit for a sale and get the pro model, which comes with the 240 hz 500 nit display *and* the 4070, and *also* has better temps and build quality. And iirc it's less than \$150 more.

The 500 nit display is quite a bit brighter than the 300 nit display, and on a laptop the display is really important. Also, the slim model is made completely of hard plastic, but the pro model has an aluminum lid.

For reference, I got the Legion Pro 5i for \$1379 pre-tax

Legion Pro 5i has both the 4070 and the better display, *and* better build quality and temps. It's worth the price difference

Intel i7-14650HX plus Rtx 4060 most likely since the other one is an older third gen Ryzen with only 8 cores 16 threads so the CPU in the 4060 model is significantly more powerful, and is gonna deliver quite a large CPU performance improvement, however the Rtx 4070 Gpu can perform as much as 30% faster than the 4060 especially in Ray tracing demanding titles but it's not always that much faster and could be around 15% to 20% max in some games maybe less so it's gonna be a difficult choice.

I'd probably take the Intel with the 16 cores 24 threads plus Rtx 4060 if the screen is as good as the other model but then again the older Ryzen is probably gonna deliver good enough CPU performance for most games where the 4070 could be the much better choice but I don't wanna influence your decision making so that's all I'm gonna say.

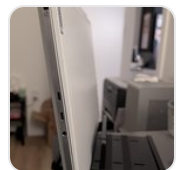

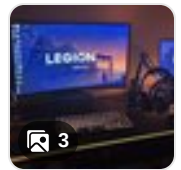

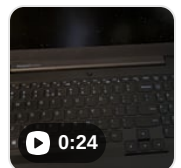
