Your ISP will see (at a minimum) DNS requests for any of those apps that don't go through VPN (and depending on your VPN provider, they may get DNS info even if it is routed through a VPN server). In the US, browsing torrent trackers/sites is not illegal, and likely won't cause you any conflict from your ISP.

Torrenting copyrighted material in the US *is* illegal, so if you intend on doing that, your torrent/usenet client will need to go through VPN so that your ISP can't identify that traffic. But the bigger threat is your home IP address being captured by someone in the swarm that is getting IPs on behalf of copyright holders, in order to take action through ISPs. *That* is the main benefit that a VPN offers: the IP that the swarm sees is the IP of a VPN server.

Some people route *everything* through VPN as a precautionary measure.
