I use it for most of my clients. It is pretty darn good - nothing is perfect but currently it is my goto recommendation. Next year that might change. The truth is that after using a 16" 16:10 laptop at 1.2 kg, everything else seems small and/or heavy. This has changed how, where and when I use the laptop, which means any other laptop would need me to rethink that. No other that I have found, offers the following 3 things in one:

- 1.2 kg weight
- 16" 16:10 aspect ratio screen
- high performance processor and ram for the weight

My only complaint is that several keys on the keyboard have literally cracked into pieces. That said, I have been looking very hard for a replacement laptop, and anything I find, has at least one of the following worse than the LG Gram 16z90s (the current 2024 model):

- as light, but smaller screen and/or lower performance.
- as large and performant but weighing almost 2 kg!

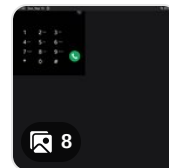

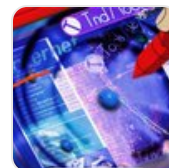
