Review: The Galaxy Book5 Pro 360 changed my mind on 16-inch, Intel-powered laptops

I thought the Samsung Galaxy Book5 Pro 360 would be too big and too much of a battery hog, but I was wrong. My past experiences with Intel-based laptops have been either disappointing or middling...but I'm happy to say that my time with the Book5 Pro 360 has been great!

Samsung loaned me the laptop a little over a month ago, and this comes just a short while after I purchased the Snapdragon X Elite-powered Yoga Slim 7X, so I was curious to see how the two would compare in terms of ergonomics, battery life, day-to-day performance, and productivity. There are some aspects of the laptop that I'm not a fan of (more on that below), but overall, I've really enjoyed using this over my Slim 7X so far.

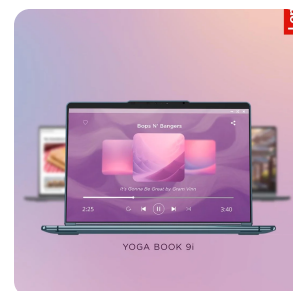

Appreciate the detailed review! I own the Book 4 Pro 360, but dropped it in favor of the Asus Zenbook S16 HX365. I think the Asus is the overall better laptop, owing to 24GB of ram and just the HX365 Ryzen chip is a beast in performance in general. The keyboard also has way more key travel on the Asus, I found the Samsung one very shallow and mushy. The 360 does have a noticeably brighter OLED screen however, and the flip hinge does come in handy sometimes, as does the SPen support.

If Samsung ever offered a 32GB variant, I would bite and trade it in, but as it stands the 16GB gets filled up just in general everyday tasks like chrome/youtube/etc that it makes zero sense to trade down from my Zenbook at this point even if the Lunar Lake chips do offer much better battery efficiency and stronger iGPU.

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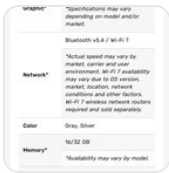
