Review of Carlinkit 5.0 Wireless CarPlay&Android Auto Adapter

This review is for the Wireless CarPlay Android Auto Adapter [Carlinkit 5.0](#). I got the Carlinkit CarPlay Adapter (\$62.99 on <https://carlinkitlife.com/> Use the discount code "USD30OFF" to get \$30 of) As the product name implies, this [Carlinkit 5.0](#) supports either Apple CarPlay or Android Auto Wireless. However, my review only covers the Apple CarPlay function since I do not have access to an Android phone. The car used in the review is a Toyota Rav4 2022 and the phone is an older iPhone 12.
