

Gnome vs Cinnamon, Should I switch?

I'm using arch linux right now, and am looking for further customization of my desktop. I have heard mixed things about Cinnamon's ability to be customized, but I figured I'd ask reddit about it lol. Is cinnamon good for customization? or should I stick with gnome? if so what are some extensions you'd recommend



Big Cinnamon fan here. I've been happy with the customization options, but it depends on what you want to do. I'd say it has fewer actively developed extensions than Gnome, but it needs fewer because it has saner defaults (just my opinion) and a good amount of customization available without requiring you to install extensions first. In particular, it has a very nice dock setup, with lots of customization options. The dock gives it a Windows-like feel, though I'm sure you could go for a different feel.

When I was just getting started, I coded up my own applet (extension for putting something on the dock) by combining two existing applets--from what I've seen, this is easier in Cinnamon than in most DEs, but you still have to get your hands dirty (it uses javascript). (EDIT: For the record, I wanted an applet to support a 2D grid of workspaces, which already exists, but I wanted to be able to see the shape of the windows in each workspace, which was available in a different applet. Good luck setting up any kind of 2d workspace grid in Gnome.)

Gnome has better gesture controls than Cinnamon, although Cinnamon has improved in this area and may fully catch up in an update or two. And Gnome has Wayland, if that's a priority for you--Cinnamon Wayland support is coming maybe next year. I'd say those could be the reasons _not_ to use Cinnamon. Personally I don't feel the need to use Wayland in 2024.




