Any idea what might be the issue here? Would appreciate any tips.



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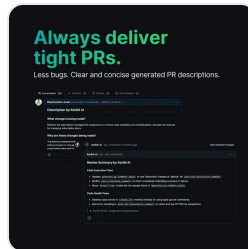
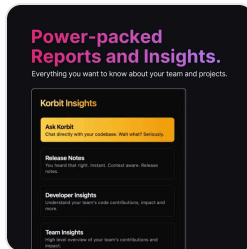
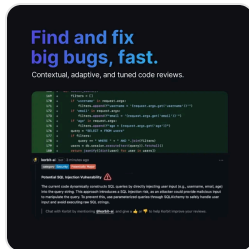
