I'm looking for a dock to connect an external monitor and 8+ USB peripherals. It would need to also output 4k@120 hz.



That many USB ports with the 4K@120Hz puts it into a crazy category: not sure which laptop you have, but this will do one monitor 4K@120Hz/144Hz on any Apple Silicon laptop.

There's docks/hubs that will do 4K@120Hz that are less than \$100, but have nowhere near the amount of USB ports you are looking for... this comes in at 7 USB ports.

Will also power/charge your laptop.

If you're working with Thunderbolt 3 / 4, you can daisy-chain docks. I know it's not as clean and requires two power plugs, but getting a 3 USB-C Thunderbolt dock could then run USB-C to HDMI or DisplayPort, along with another dock loaded with various ports.

If you're plugging a bunch of USB-A, along with really cheap docks at the end of a daisy chain, many of those 3 USB-C Thunderbolt docks also have 1 USB-A.
