Is there a way to enable Moonlight/Windows to load up an account on start up rather than upon logging in?

Trying to remote into my PC, but every once in a while, an update will restart my computer.

I can't remote in with Moonlight unless I'm physically present to login to my account (and thus start all the processes needed to get Moonlight working). Is there any way to bypass this like having a user account load up necessary processes without being logged in first?

Note that I would still like to keep my password locking just for physical access protection (I live with nosy people)

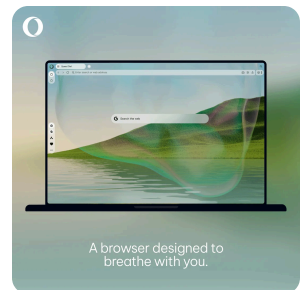

I had this same issue and the only way I found to get around this is set up windows as password-less, then have Task Scheduler lock the workstation a few seconds after logon. This way if the system restarts you will auto log back in and load everything, but the system will lock itself. I used this tutorial:
