Private DNS provider hostname cannot be deleted once I've entered a hostname and saved it

This is an annoying problem I'm having. I installed AdGuard and whenever I went shopping, couldn't connect to their in store WiFi.

I tried excluding their app from AdGuard and switching off DNS protection, and which DID work once, but didn't work next time I went in.

I tried changing DNS hostnames in the AdGuard app to cloudflare - still didn't work.

I turned off DNS protection again and added the cloudflare hostname (one.one.one.one) into my private DNS settings on my Android phone thinking this might work because I've always needed to have my DNS setting on 'automatic' to access the public wifi in store. Still didn't work.

But here's my problem..

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My router has an option to override ipv6 DNS server address but doesn't accept my pihole's ipv6 address
