# Constant "Private DNS server cannot be accessed" and internet drops

Been having this issue for a few days now. Here is how it goes:

- 1. I connect to Wifi with Private DNS set to off.
- 2. I change Private DNS to <a href="mailto:dns.adguard-dns.com">dns.adguard-dns.com</a>
- 3. I get error "Private DNS server cannot be accessed".
- 4. Wifi is connected but no internet.
- 5. Sometimes, it connects, goes through and works for a few minutes. Then it just hangs and no internet. No DNS errors.
- 6. I disable Private DNS. Internet starts working again. I try to set Private DNS to Adguard and I start back at #3.
- 7. When I set to NextDNS, zero issues.
