I've been using qBittorrent for 2+ years now and I can confidently say it's the best torrent client for your homelab server right now. I've tried using Rutorrent, Deluge, Transmission in between the course and have faced bugs and eventually quit using it and switched back to qBittorrent. Btw I've noticed qBit takes a bit too much RAM and CPU if you've kept the default configuration. Try to restrict the number of active torrent downloads, bandwidth etc. If your hardware faces too much load from qBittorrent.

I really haven't seen much improvement in speed though. The binhex has been very solid as well so I didn't see a need to switch back.

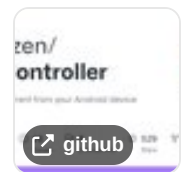
