Can't access docker app through Nginx Reverse Proxy

Hi everyone!

I have been using Nginx Reverse Proxy Manager on my unRAID server for over 5-6 months I was able to use it for wordpress websites, nextcloud (which is running on another server) but for some reason, I can't make docker containers to be accessible using a subdomain.

I have watched many videos and read multiple articles about it but still can't make it work. In theory, it should work but it's not.

For this example, I would like to make [UptimeKuma](#) be accessible from the domain [status.domain.com](#). I have a subdomain setup which is pointing to my public IP. Port 80 and 443 is forwarded to the correct ports of NPM.

Here is a picture of the reverse proxy settings page:

Just by that, I would assume that your UptimeKuma isn't working correctly or throwing the error.

Whatever the case, check the log files of those containers and not just the container logs but also and more specifically the applications.

For example, the nginxproxymanager has an error.log file in your appdata/NginxProxyManager/logs folder.

I would imagine that the UptimeKuma also generates log files somewhere.

I managed to get it working by changing the network type to custom instead of bridge and assigned a custom ip address to UptimeKuma and now, I can access it from the internet.

Side effect is that it doesn't see any other docker app but as I know, it can be solved by creating a custom docker network.

I have checked the logs of nginx and it says that connect failed (113: Host is unreachable) while connecting to upstream. upstream: ip_of_upstreamekuma, host: status.domain.com, referrer: ip_of_proxy_manager/nginx/proxy

Strangely, I can connect to the upstream ip address without any issue.

I'm still searching for the log files of UptimeKuma.

That referrer seems to be weird because wh I open status.domain.com, it redirects me after a few seconds to that referrer ip address which is local and that goes back to the domain and throws error 502.
