Setting up Samba share in docker. What is purpose of mounting a volume vs -s?

Set up a dperson/samba container in docker on Ubuntu server. In order to set up a share I used the following command in the compose file: `command: '-p -u "user1;badpass" -s "etl_share;/mount/etl_share;no;no;no;user1"'` which mounts a share called `etl_share` that is located at `/mnt/etl_share` on the host. This works fine. But I also see in some docs that they use `-v` to mount a volume. Why do that in addition to `-s`?

Docker run from Docs:

-u "example1;badpass" \
-u "example2;badpass" \
-s "public;/share" \
-s "users:/srv/np:np:np:example1 example2" \
```

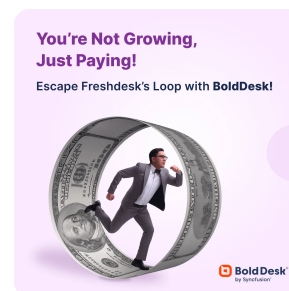

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if you only have -v, then you have the directory available in the container, but you didn't tell samba to do anything with it, so it won't show up in samba

if you have only -s, then the container can't see the directory mounted in -v. You would probably get an error like "directory not found"

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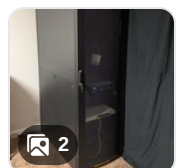

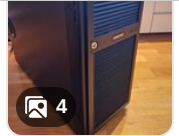

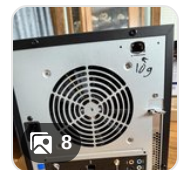
