
'Initialized' an already working SSD and made it disappear from PC

Sandisk Extreme Portable External SSD | NTFS

So, somehow, I just made a huge mistake. I plugged in my old internal hard drives from my main PC via a Sabrent hard drive docking station. Neither of them show up, so I go into disk management. Keep in mind I have a Sandisk External SSD plugged in to another port while doing this.

A message pops up in disk manager "Disk needs to be initialized to be viewed" (or something like that). I was like okay that must be one of the hard drives (stupid, I know). I click okay (with GPT partition) and my SanDisk SSD instantly disappears from "This PC", with the full 2TB showing up as unallocated in disk manager.

Needless to say this got my heart racing, and after a reboot it stays the same. I read a few posts and ran R-Studio and was able to scan the drive and see the files. I don't believe the files are damaged but I want to proceed carefully. I saw other posts recommending DMDE, so I downloaded that as well.



If this is an SSD should remove it from computer and leave powered off until you get more advice here.

If any issue where data get "deleted" best to leave off until get advice from a pro as they have a feature called trim. If data is deleted some time (unknown amount few min's, maybe an hour never know how long so that's why turning off soon as is important) after SSD'd do "housekeeping" and clean themselves (with trim). If that happens it become very very hard if not impossible to recover data



As the other poster says TRIM and garbage rountines can begin to chew away at the data. So disconnect the drive (if not already done so) and turn off TRIM on your PC https://www.windowscentral.com/how-ensure-trim-enabled-windows-10-speed-ssd-performance. The bottom of that piece tells you how to turn TRIM off.

Reconnect the drive. As you have scanned the drive with R-Studio, I suggest the quickest way is to reload the scan and save the data off to another drive ASAP.


