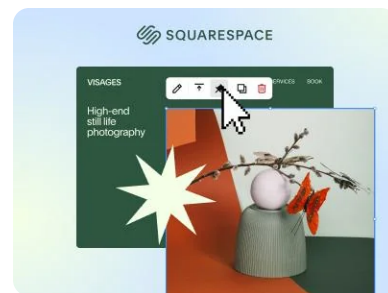

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It can still be forced by modifying the acf files of each library folder before you start Steam. Games with pending updates have a "ScheduledAutoUpdate" value inside the acf file. If you replace the value with an Unix timestamp of the current time, on the next start, Steam will automatically download the updates. Barely anyone seems to be aware of this, and I haven't seen anyone made a script or tool for this yet, but it's technically possible.
