

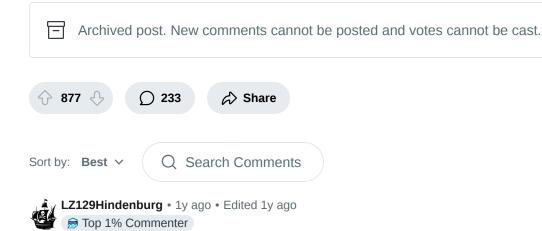

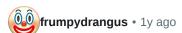


Can you explain massgrave to me? I've had free windows on my computer that's so old that I've forgotten why. If it ever dies, I'll be in trouble.
