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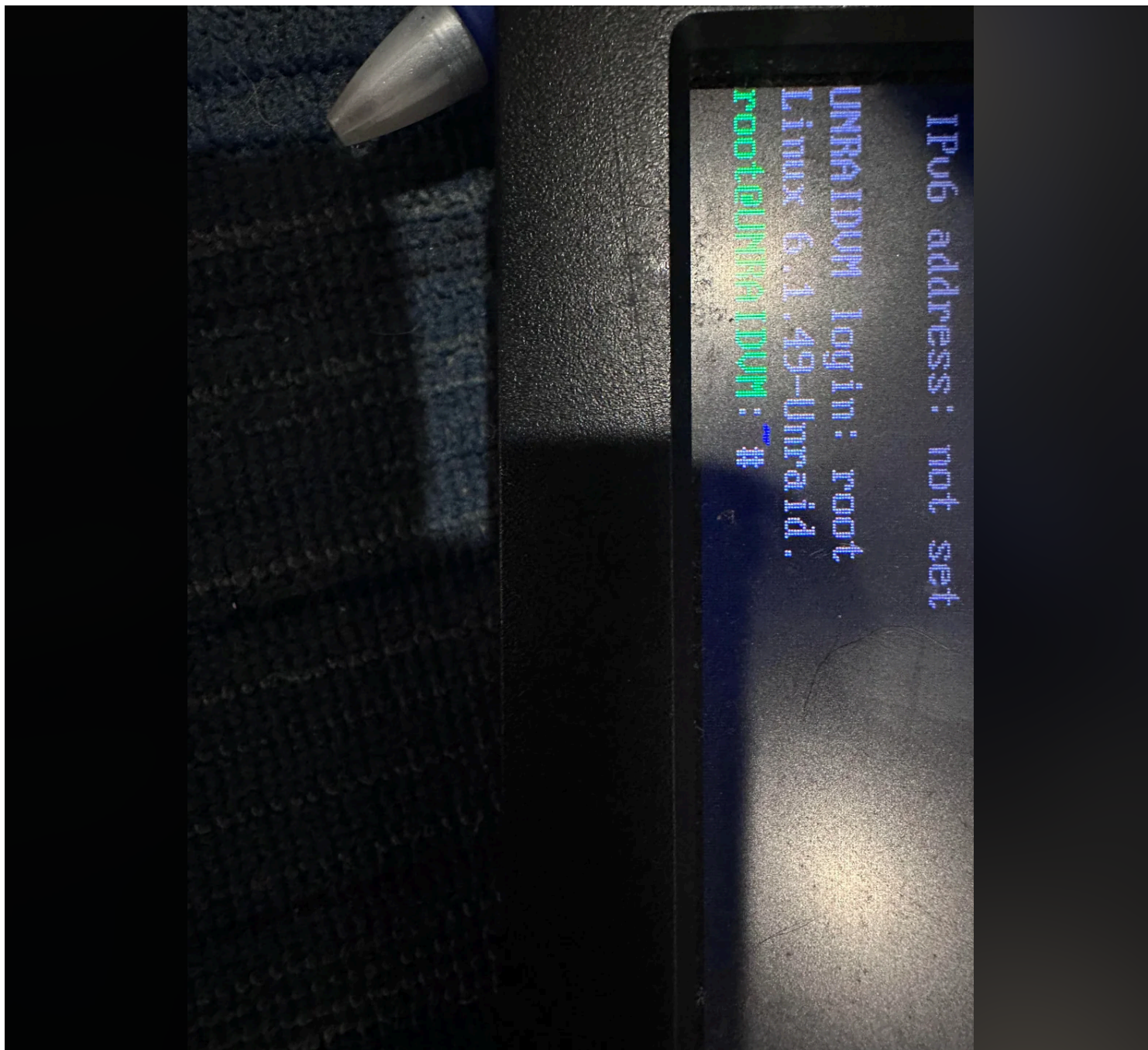

unRAID doesn't install any OS, it is designed to run live from USB. It has two very easy GUIs for configuration - one accessible at boot time for local setup and another network enabled web server which is the default for most users. If your unRAID server is not connected to your network via a wired ethernet cable then local access is your only option. As most folks use unRAID primarily as a NAS (Network Attached Storage) and Plex server (in Docker) solution it makes sense to connect it to your network, otherwise you won't be getting the most out of it. Good luck and welcome to the club, I hope you enjoy using your unRAID server as much as many of us have.

[This](#) post shows an example local IPv4 address after starting unRAID connected to LAN so after that you'd just use another machine on same network to browse to the unRAID web GUI on `http://<IP-ADDRESS>/` to connect to it. Hopefully this makes sense!

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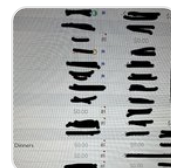

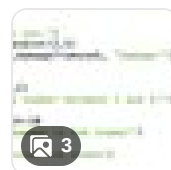
