I'm attempting to reinstall my Debian 12 with FDE, since, I didn't realize that you couldn't do this at a later time.

Most of the tutorials I'm watching say to click "manual".

And then, they all say something a little different. And most of them are using VM's to do the install.


So, I just got a little worried I would click the wrong thing, or fuck something up.

The debian installer makes luks/btrfs hard when it's easy on other distributions. There is https://spirallinux.github.io/ that makes it easy though... it has some presets you can disable https://www.reddit.com/r/debian/comments/zbe73d/comment/jytrqnd/







I tried to make that easy and accessible to everyone, as per the Debian Social Contract.

Or you can select "use the whole disk and set up encrypted LVM", **BUT** only if you truly want to use the full disk. So that's a no go for dual booting. Also, /boot will be encrypted this way, so that's a plus or minus, depending on what you want.


