



Is it possible to play Destiny 2 in Windows VM?


As is written on the Steam page (under "Steam Deck support"), Destiny 2 doesn't support Linux even when using Proton, because of the game's anti-cheat. But is it possible to use Linux with Windows virtual machine to play the game? I'm asking because I don't want to run Windows natively, but my friend wants me to give this game a try.





Thing is - at the start, for few days, Destiny 2 used to work great, even BE worked. It's just Bungie who made the game specifically incompatible with Proton/Wine ONLY.

As for VM - nope, anti-VM measurers. You'd have to run Windows machine on KVM and another one inside on Hyper-V, that *may* work, but you'd most probably get banned. And I wouldn't count on D2 on Linux anytime soon, anyway as long as those dumbasses at Bungie call Linux gamers "dirty hackers"...



Even if Destiny uses Anti-VM features, its not perfect and it will be possible to bypass, just be careful if you do.

So we are stuck in this dilemma and Bungie with the lawsuits (resources spent on the lawyers they had to deal with legal issues). Maybe a few years in a Linux port or proton support will come up...





The issue is not Linux itself Bungie have a problem with. It's running the game off a platform they don't officially support and control which is the issue.

Stadia was purely server-side so they only need to trust Google.

I don't think this is justified as well but it is easy to see their point of view.


