Probably entering a couple of commands would have solved everything. Rather than investigating what precisely those commands might be, I used the approach described above and it resulted in a working LXQT installation.

Using the graphical installer I selected LXQt and deselected GNOME. I also added ssh server. I left the debian desktop environment selected.

After installation it booted into sddm and LXQt was the only option available which was what it logged in into. There was no KDE installed at all.

So I could not reproduce what you said... Although I just noticed you were using the DVD-1 iso instead of the netinst (any reason for that? You don't have internet on the computer you're installing it?).

I still doubt that would be the reason for what happened to you though...
