Portmaster blocking LAN access to one host

While updating Plex on my NAS yesterday, I suddenly lost access to the NAS. Spent too many hours troubleshooting the NAS and my Win 10 PC before I realized it was just my PC that couldn't ping or contact the NAS in any way.

Tracing route to qnap [[10.4.0.200](#)]

over a maximum of 30 hops:

1 MYPC [[127.0.0.1](#)] reports: Destination protocol unreachable.

Every other PC and device worked fine. After resetting the network connections in Windows, trying pretty much everything except banging my head against the wall, I disabled Portmaster on a whim. Access came back immediately. Once I re-enable Portmaster, the NAS is blocked again.

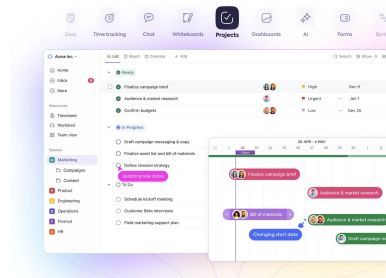

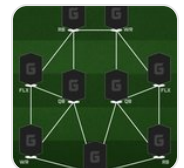

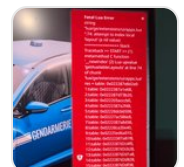
