I've bought a couple PiKVM V4 pluses (the complete kit) and they're vastly more expensive than what these appear to be... at least according to pre-order pricing on their site.

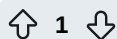
It sounds like an even cleaner, commercially-supported option that rivals PiKVM?

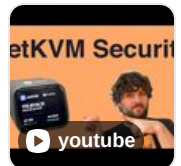

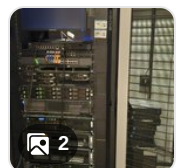
