Reverse Proxy Help

I am attempting to setup a reverse proxy using Nginx on my Windows 10 machine. The purpose of this endeavor is to be able to access my services from outside my home network. However, I am running into issues. Here is my setup:

- Sonarr/Radarr/others installed as a Windows service
- Base URLs set to /sonarr, /radarr, ...
- I own a domain through Namecheap (<https://camjewell.com>)
- DDNS URLs (?) through noIP (<https://camjewell.hopto.org>) and afraid freeDNS (<https://camjewell.crabdance.com>)
- Ports 80 and 443 forwarded to my machine (local IP 192.x.x.102)
- Possible issue Google Fiber does not allow external traffic through port 80 or 443
- As a result of the possible block I opened port 8080 as well

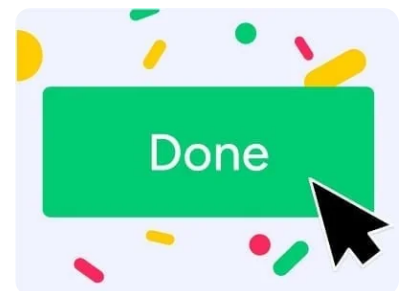

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I'd also strongly suggest ignoring guides that are for EOL programs and versions of software that are ~7 years old. Specifically for [HTPCGuides](#) Sonarr v2 is EOL and Nginx 1.6.2 was released as an emergency security fix in 2014. Nginx 1.7 was already out at that time. Currently Nginx is on 1.21 for context.

You also do not need two DDNS services they serve no point in duplicating the work. Additionally, if you have your own domain then there is 0 reason to have a ddns service. You just have a program to update your a record with whoever is providing your domain's DNS service. Alternatively, just drop to 1 DDNS service and keep the cname pointed at it.

Troubleshooting wise in order:

- test the conf and see if it passes; correct if needed
- attempt access and check router logs to see if there is any incoming traffic / if any is being blocked; correct if needed
- review nginx logs (error and regular) to see what they report; google/troubleshoot as needed
- circle back with the details of the above and nginx logs.

SSL wise; you only need to have it setup for your RP only, not any internal networking. i.e. Do not use SSL to go RP -> sonarr internally. proxy to the apps should be HTTP. the proxy itself should serve on https

with all of that said, none of this is a sonarr specific issue and is rather a reverse proxy issue. Thus Rule 3. As such - post locked in lieu of removal. This would better be suited for [r/HomeNetworking](#)

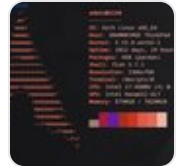

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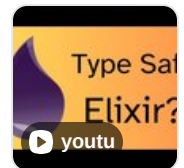

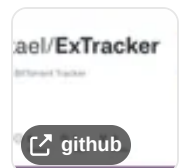
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After 3+ years without any major issues, Sonarr and Radarr are going haywire and wreaking havoc on my plex server.
