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

It's a place people still play, and can but a large majority will transition into the new "league" refreshing everything from a fresh economy to a new build meta and league mechanic/some new thing.

In this case our characters would go to "Ea" league and all subsequent characters will as well until full release, then transition into "standard".

I'm not sure if they are even sure how this will work. In general, I think players should expect changes to be more abrupt in EA than in a full release. The point is to make improvements to the game, and I'm personally fine if that necessitates a league reset or some other drastic change.

Basically, if the league length is a real priority I'd recommend holding off on EA. You can always just give POE 1 a spin for free to see if you like it.

It's not completely worked out yet. They talked about it a bit in the interview they gave yesterday and the gist of it is that they haven't decided what exactly they are going to add and how many times they are going to do resets during the early access.

All of your items, your characters and everything that was from the last league is moved to Standard. If this is your first league, you keep the same stashes and everything, and the content that was new for the last league is no longer available (usually league content gets added to the main game later, once they balance it to be around long term instead of short term). You can choose to continue playing on Standard if you want, and you'll still have a good time. Most don't though. If it's not your first league, then you already have items in your stashes from past leagues being moved to Standard, so you get Remove Only stash tabs. So you still have all your items, but they're not just continuously adding on to your available stash space. Remove only means just that. You can leave stuff in them, you can take stuff out of them and put them into your regular stash tabs, but you cannot put anything new in them. If you take an item out, even for an instant, you can't even return it. Once it's out, you have to put it in one of your regular stash tabs.

The new league starts, and it's like you've never played the game before. You keep all your cosmetics, all your stash tabs, but every single item you've earned in the past is not available in the new league. It resets the economy, so if there was something about it that was broken before, it gives it a fresh start.

What most people who read these descriptions miss out on though, is that nearly everyone (more than 90% of us) instead of dreading losing a character, actually look forward to starting a new one. After a couple months, you've probably created at least 2 or 3, and often more, different characters anyway in the last league. You've done everything you wanted to do, you've earned as much as you wanted to earn, you've taken a break from the game, and you're ready to start again.

New leagues in 1 always come with new content, and new skills to try. The main game stays the same, but they change enough and add enough that you're itching to try it out.

It will likely be a similar process in 2. The economy will reset, they will introduce changes, and probably significant changes. But instead of introducing brand new content, in EA, they will likely be introducing things that they've already told us about but haven't implemented yet. So I would assume economy resets around the same time as introducing new characters, or introducing new acts, or adding a large amount of skill gems, or introducing weapons. They probably want it to have the kind of content amount that we see from leagues in 1, but are hesitant to call them "leagues" because these aren't brand new concepts, so to them it's different.

How do they deal with multiple leagues' worth of characters and their stash tabs all piling up in standard? To make it simple, say I have 1 stash tab. Each league I play one character and I fill my 1 stash tab. 3 leagues pass. Does this mean in standard I now have 3 characters, and 1 full stash tab from the first league, and no items from 2+3 because it was already full? Or do I have 3 separate standard stashes that aren't tied together? I'm assuming I don't now have 3 stash tabs in standard, because in this example lets say I only ever paid for my 1 single stash tab.

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And if that one tab was a specialty tab, say currency, you would have a regular currency tab that you can remove or add to, and 2 remove only currency tabs.

There won't be any need to make new characters nor new league mechanics to experience during Early Access. They will have resets and allow people to choose to start over, but you will always have the option to keep playing your existing characters. If you have never played PoE1 before and you want to play PoE2, there is zero reason to wait for a league reset, which won't even be an actual league...because it's still Early Access.

This is a big claim and might not be true. They very well could create an "Early Access - ver1" league to migrate everyone to, and create an "Early Access - ver2" league and only introduce new content on the new ver 2 league. We can only speculate how exactly it will be implemented.

There is nothing to suggest this, nor do we have any reason to believe that GGG will shell out the cost for multiple separate long-term servers of increasingly dwindling size. Everything suggests that the entirety of EA will remain together.



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Fact #1 - Before Early Access started, they stated that all characters from EA will remain after the full launch, they will just be in their own league.

Fact #2 - In the recent interview, they confirmed there will be an economic reset during EA. The only feasible way to do that is to put everyone on an even playing field again.

Logical conclusion - They won't remove all items from everyone, because that will essentially brick all existing characters. They also won't just remove all items in stash tabs, leaving equipment alone. That will leave the higher levelled, better geared people at a distinct advantage.

Way more likely is they create a separate economy, where the original characters cannot intermingle with the new characters. This is the only reasonable way that they maintain both claims that I stated.

There is nothing stopping them from turning the current "Standard" into "EA - Standard" and create an "EA - ver 2" league. Then when they're ready to do another economy reset, the merge "EA - Standard" and "EA - ver 2", then delete "EA - ver 2" and create "EA - ver 3".

Since that is how Poe 1 has worked for so long, I can all but guarantee that that option has been part of the discussion as options for handling economy resets. It also seems the most likely, but isn't guaranteed to be the way they handle it until they tell us one way or the other

Yes. I've already said all this in my first reply. They will have resets during Early Access and allow people to choose to start over. People will not be forced to start over. It will be their choice. They will not have multiple permanent legacy EA servers after EA is over. There will only be one. There is no reason to wait for one of these resets to roll around for someone who is entirely new to the franchise. They can and should just start playing now.
