

Agreed, but adding that the "quests" in Elden Ring absolutely exist, just not in the classic open world RPG format. No objectives to track in your UI or map markers to follow, you're just listening to what an NPC is telling you and trying to do what they ask. In this way it feels more like the true sense of the word "quest" than side missions in other games - there's mystery and player agency involved here.

That said, they are often pretty obtuse. You aren't given much to go on by many characters and it's quite easy to miss steps, or accidentally break quests. Some people love this, some people hate it



I also really enjoy games that have a good balance of story and combat like bg3 for example.

Compared to soulslikes in general BG3 is heavy in story, it's an RPG after all. So no, Elden Ring ain't what you're looking for.

Elden Ring is mostly gameplay -- this involves combat, tweaking and experimenting with builds, exploring the map, solving dungeons, this kind of thing. It has a very interesting story, but it's diluted in the environment, item descriptions and a few NPC interactions, and a big part of the appeal here is putting it together slowly. It's very different from something like BG3. That said it's a great game and you should give it a go if you feel inclined.
