I'm not sure if the sound difference makes the size of the pads because after my pads on my neo(after 3 years) started to flake off I tried non original pads(more expensive prom leather) and the sound quality was really bad. That bad that I like more the sound from my sony for 50usd. So the pads really matter.

I also the the bluetooth noise bose 700 and sony WF-1000XM4. I like the sony more but all the price you are because of the noise canceling and bluetooth. So both can not even reach the meze sound by far.

My brother have beyerdynamic DT 770 PRO 250 and is some songs are better than meze when you compare the side by side. But the meze I can listening music whole day. The DT 770 are exhausting for me after some time and for me the meze are worth for the extra money.

I also have KZ ZAX and I didn't ever heard better instrument separation and by far better sounded Red Hot Chili Peppers - Snow (or others songs with many instruments). But I use them not very often. I like using meze and sony. There is something about them that bothers me. I think it is because they doesn't sound good on low volume and needs to be set loud. they have to stick in their ears very deep to play well. So because of it my ears hurt after a while.
