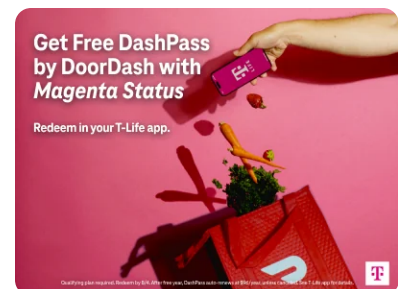

More seriously, there's nothing wrong with Baratza. For beginners a Baratza Encore is affordable and does a great job for filter coffee. Next step up for filter is Fellow Ode gen2. I run a Baratza daily for some years without issue. I recommended the Encore to two family members and they are very happy with their grinder.

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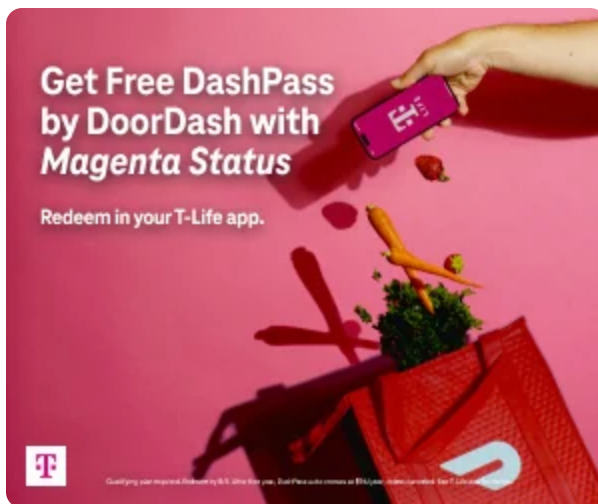

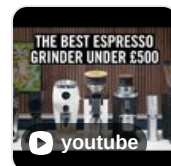
