



LE is more casual and being a full release, more complete, POE2 seems more ambitious but still at early stages with classes and ascendancies (Mastery classes) missing, in addition to class balances.

LE Season 2 looks phenomenal and as an Action RPG fan I would not hesitate grabbing it.

POE2 I would personally wait until 1.0 is finalized as it is going through constant changes that might frustrate you; obviously completely natural of a Pre-Release.
