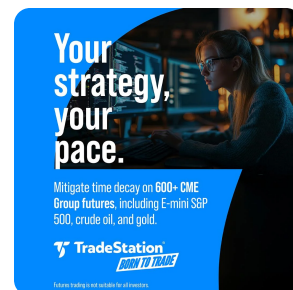

I would definitely recommend. Last Epoch has an excellent crafting system, there's sufficient depth in the gearing to chase BiS items and stats on gear. The interaction between skills and customisation of your skills are quite deep and satisfying. It's not on the level of PoE1 but it's much deeper than PoE2's EA right now (so many missing gems and only a few skills have simple pairing potential). LE has a very interesting take on trade vs SSF and I love SSF in LE (targeted loot explosions, what's not to like?)

The downside is that endgame activities are pretty much limited to monoliths and some dungeon runs for fun. It can get repetitive for some people.

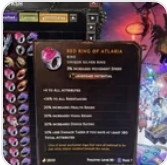
